SIRHA Executive Board

SIRHA's Executive Board is a governing body, and meets once per month in Creston on the third Wednesday of each month. They offer Zoom, and conference call options as well as mileage reimbursement for those that travel to our office for these meetings. One of those meetings diverges from routine which is the Annual Meeting held in April where we host a larger group of attendees. The Executive Board consists of 14 members with 1 appointment by each County Board of Supervisors from our service area in Southwest Iowa, and 1 representative from our Resident Advisory Council. Executive Board members assist with the oversight of the SIRHA program including reviewing the budget and ensuring we are following and meeting the program standards. SIRHA will provide each appointment with a monthly Board Packet that explains our financials and any activities happening within our organization for the month. Executive Board members have full voting rights as a member of the Board, and also act as a representative of SIRHA for their county to bring back information to their county's elected officials and community agencies. SIRHA works to provide decent and affordable housing to low-income families, and we hope that our appointees have a passion to support this vision in their own communities.

Anyone who wishes to apply may pick up a volunteer application from the Fremont County Auditor at the Fremont County Courthouse in Sidney, IA, or go to the Fremont County website at www.fremontcountya.gov.
